**Administrative Council Minutes**  
**April 19, 2017**

Cheri opened the meeting reading from Philippians 4:4-9 and prayer. Thank you notes were read for paying apportionments, special offerings, Samaritan Fund, and from the Paulsen family. Shelby volunteered to be chairperson for the May meeting.

Scholarship--Pastor will present the scholarships at graduation.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

Ham Dinner took in \$1659 but not all expenses are in yet for a final tally. It is about the same profit as last year.

Holy Week Services had a nice attendance but it was down from last year.

Lee Glenn attended to again ask about the padded chairs for the Fellowship Hall. There is \$2000 in the chair fund, which would purchase approximately 60 chairs. Due to the lack of attendees at this meeting, no vote could be taken on the matter. However, Pastor Jason will bring a sample of the Jim Falls chairs to the next meeting, It was suggested the old chairs could be put on the thrift sale in July. This will be put on the agenda for next month's meeting to vote on the sample to order.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

Thrift Sale--Discussion on if we should have it based on needing a chairperson and lack of people to tend to it.

There was discussion on announcing our tithing of fund raisers ahead of time so patrons would know where a portion of their money was going.

Attendance at the Ad. Board meeting has been declining, making it difficult to vote on issues that come before it. A reminder to all committee members that there should be a representative from each committee at the Ad. Council meeting.
