Youth Programs

To all families of Holcombe United Methodist Church: Come and "sea" the youth programs offered in our church!

Rally Day is coming September 11, 2016 from 10 AM to Noon at the Holcombe United Methodist Church. At Rally Day, kids will have some fun Games (Water Balloon Race, Sponge Tag, Drip. Drip. Drop), Face Painting, and Food (Fruit Cup Fish, Gold Fish Snacks, Sugar Cookies). There will be also a message about "Washing Away Our Sins." Parents will learn more about the various programs and sign up for Sunday School, pre-Confirmation class, and 2017 Vacation Bible School. We hope you can join us!

Sunday School is a Christian education program for kids in Kindergarten through fifth grade using a "one room school" curriculum for our children. Classes are held during our church service and running partially through Fellowship after service (9-10 AM). We will have a short Christmas program and Easter program during the year. We also serve fellowship once a month on Communion Sunday (the first Sunday of the month). We ask families to sign up to provide the snacks and the Sunday School will serve and clean up.

Pre-Confirmation Class. Hello to all students of the Holcombe United Methodist church in grades 6 through 8. My name is Elizabeth Hillebrand and I will be co-teaching the class designed for those students preparing to enter confirmation classes. We will be using a curriculum titled "What's Up? Discovering the Gospel, Jesus, and Who You REALLY Are". I am excited to offer a class that will focus on the Gospel, what Jesus teaches us and what we need to do to apply it to our everyday lives. The class will meet almost every Sunday morning right after regular 8:30am Worship Service (and after we have had a most sustaining and refreshing snack so we can stay attentive to our lesson!!). A Message From the UMC Mission's Committee

Coming on Sunday, October 2, 2016—World Communion Sunday. There will be a special offering taken to support the designated ministries of the United Methodist Church. Your gifts to this offering help to support 3 vital programs:

- 50% of the offering provides scholarships for international and U.S. racial & ethnic minority graduate students (World Communion Scholars).
- 35% of the offering supports ethnic scholarships for undergraduate students.
- 15% funds the Ethnic In-Service Training Program for racial & ethnic minority people seeking second careers in church related vocations.

In the past, these funds have provided scholarships in many countries of Africa, Asia, plus in North, Central & South America.

A brief history of this special offering--This offering began in 1940 as a global, interdenominational event and was called "World-Wide Communion Sunday". In 1971, the United Methodist Church changed the name of the observance to "World Communion Sunday" and redistributed the offering to support the Crusade Scholarship Program, the Ethnic Minority Scholarship Program and the Division of Chaplains & Related Ministries. In 1980, the Chaplains & Related Ministries was moved to World Service Funding but the World Communion Sunday offering continued to assist racial & ethnic minority people pursuing various avenues of ministry. In 2008, General Conference changed the name "Crusade Scholars" to World Communion Scholars".

We can help to empower world-changers around the globe by contributing to this special offering. To quote Nelson Mandela – "Education is the most powerful weapon you can use to change the world".
